

WHPC Meeting 7th February 2023 Item 23/048-1 West Hill Playpark: Annual WHPC Maintenance Check 2023

The inspection was carried out by Cllr Carr and the Parish Clerk on Monday 17th January 2023. The weather over the preceding weeks was cold and very wet.

1. General appearance of Playpark

- clearly a popular facility,
- grassed areas were muddy due to significant rainfall
- no significant weeds
- The playpark was littered with fallen leaves.

2. Findings

Appendix A provides an assessment of each piece of equipment in the playpark and of the surrounding boundaries. A summary of the findings is shown below:

- 3. Playpark Inspections
 - RoSPA: The Annual Report for the RoSPA Inspection of the Playpark. was received in Sep 2022. The report was considered at the 1st November 2022 WHPC meeting. The agreed actions have been completed
 - Lengthsman to top up soil levels around the Climbing Frame to minimise trip hazard. Completed
 - Installation of an additional safety mat on the bank underneath the climbing frame. **Completed**
 - b. EDDC: Monthly inspections are carried out and any exception reported to WHPC
 - No outstanding issues
 - c. Weekly: The playpark is inspected by Cllrs on a weekly basis. The inspections rarely report anything other than a few items of litter, however during 2022 some inspections reported criminal damage (burnt picnic bench, graffiti). These incidents have been reported to Council (as the Police) and appropriate action taken.
- 4. Maintenance

The contract with the WHPC Lengthsman, PLG Services includes

- Grass cutting during the growing season March October
- Timber treatment clear water repellant applied
- Playboat maintenance no future requirement as the item has been removed.
- Hedge cutting low beech hedge plus inside face of West Hill Road boundary hedge (VH Trustees are responsible for cutting the top and road facing side.
