VILLAGE LENGTHSMAN SPECIFICATION for 2020-2021

West Hill Parish Council is inviting applications for a part-time Lengthsman. The Parish Lengthsman is a self-employed person who can really make a difference to the community environment by maintaining roadside verges and drainage.

You are invited to provide a quote for

1. Cutting road verges to ensure visibility especially at junctions.

Locations to include

- o Junction B3180 & Bendarroch Road
- o Junction Bendarroch Road & School Lane
- West Hill Road -Village Gateway (near Lower Broad Oak Road)
- o Entrance to Broad Oak Plantation on Higher Broad Oak Road
- o Entrance to Broad Oak Plantation on Lower Broad Oak Road
- o Junction Higher Broad Oak Road & Oak Road
- Junction Lower Broad Oak Road & Ash Hill Road

Frequency: Verges to be cut three times per annum - May/June, September and late October/November.

2. Keeping road signs clean and clear from vegetation. This work to be done twice per annum - Jun/July and October/November.

Plus, please provide an hourly rate for ad hoc work which may include:

- 3. Additional verge cutting.
- 4. Clearing ditches to ensure a good flow of water to avoid localised flooding.
- 5. Other similar works such as
 - keeping footpaths useable and signs maintained (those not currently covered by DCC maintenance)
 - works to enhance woodland area as directed by council
- 6. On occasion duties may include other small-scale maintenance work

GENERAL

All areas must be litter picked prior to mowing.

Care must be taken when strimming near to tree trunks.

Allowance should be made for use of own tools, machines and materials.

Any defects in the Council's property/land which are observed in the course of the contract should be reported to the Clerk to the Council.

Please ensure your tender accommodates all detail contained within the schedule.

The contract will be awarded for a term of one year subject to satisfactory references.

The Contractor will wholly be responsible for the following:
